# Cluedunnit Kids Competition

## Mission Investigate

The *Cluedunnit Kids* Competition involves students working in teams of up to seven investigating a fictional criminal offence with the goal of identifying the offender.

Students are given a brief that includes a police statement of facts, witness statements and forensic evidence and are encouraged to ask questions about the incident.

The *Cluedunnit Kids* Competition is particularly relevant for the Year 5 and 6 Western Australian Curriculum Civics and Citizenship programme.

The Competition strives to teach students about the consequences of breaking the law in a non-threatening environment.

All members of the investigation teams receive a commemorative certificate and the winning team is awarded a trophy and a book pack for their school.
