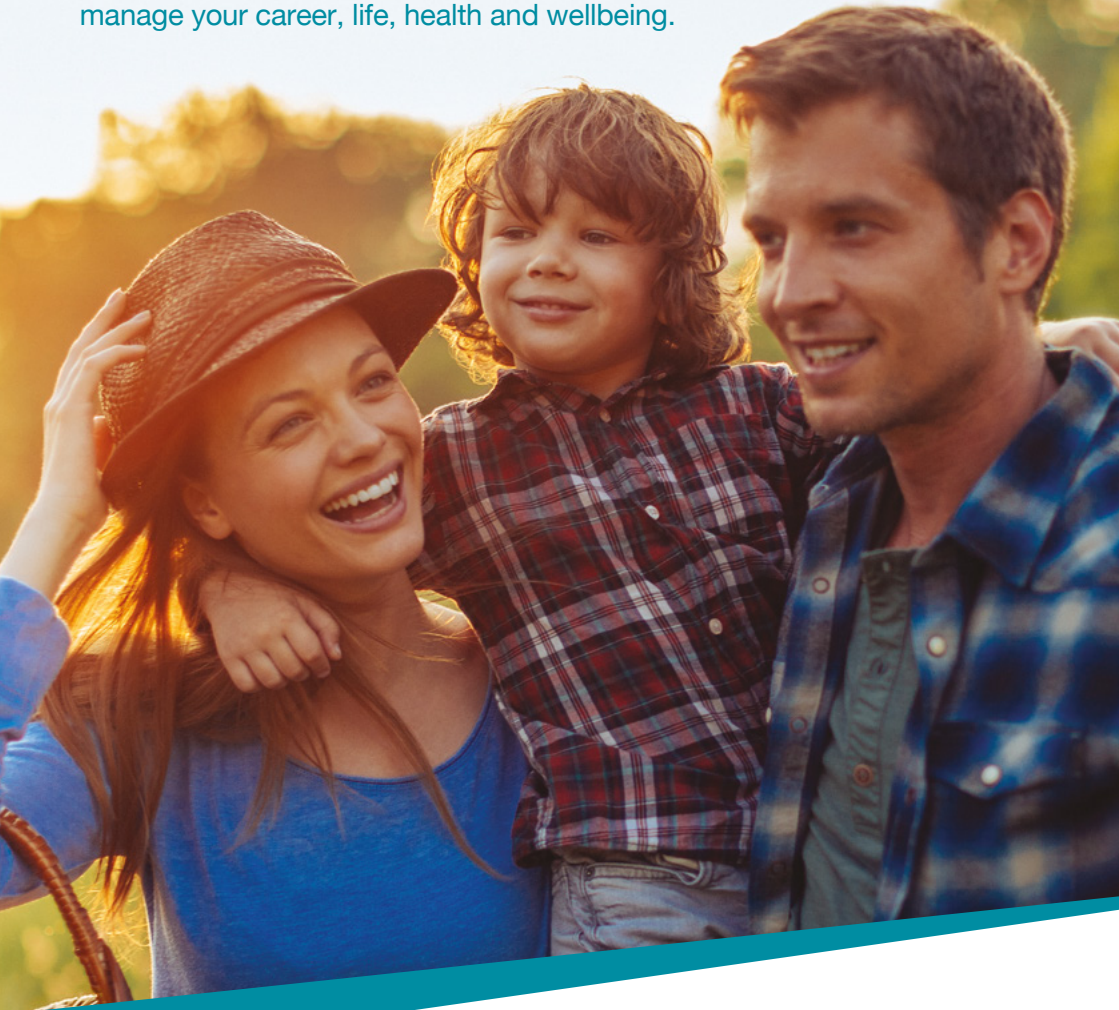

Employee Relations Advice Line

LawCare WA offers a free confidential telephone advice service to members on personal matters relating to a range of human resources and employee relations issues including*:

- Wage rates
- Award and agreement interpretation
- Performance management and termination
- Unfair dismissals
- Equal opportunity, bullying and harassment
- Employee minimum entitlements

The Employee Relations Advice Line is available 8.00am to 5.00pm Monday to Thursday and 8.00am to 4.00pm on Friday. The service is closed on weekends and public holidays.

Practitioner Advice

The **Senior Advisors Panel** connects members with experienced practitioners to confidentially discuss professional conduct and ethical issues.*

The **Western Australian Bar Association Referral Service** offers legal assistance, usually fee free or for a reduced fee from a senior counsel or senior junior, for practitioners dealing with a complaint by the Legal Profession Complaints Committee.
