



## Mock Trial Competition

### A guide for parents and supporters

#### Please arrive on time

1. Students should arrive at the Court House by 5.30pm. The trial starts at 6.00pm
2. There must be at least four team members present by 6.15pm or the team will forfeit
3. The main door to the 1903 Supreme Court Building in Stirling Gardens is locked from 6.30pm to 8.00pm.  
Latecomers cannot be admitted

#### Court and Courtroom Etiquette

4. Strictly no photography or videography inside the Court building at any time (photographs outside the building are permitted)
5. No use of mobile phones in the court room (includes students as well as parents/supporters in the gallery)
6. No food in the court room. Students may bring a bottle of water to drink (includes parents/supporters in the gallery)
7. Comply with any directions given by security staff

#### Competition Etiquette

8. This is a competition in name, but in nature it is an educational programme. Please treat all participants with courtesy and respect
9. Parents and coaches may not communicate with team members in any way during the trial

#### Departing the Court House

10. The time that the trial concludes may vary. At times, trials may finish early.
11. Students must not depart the Court building without informing their teacher, as the teacher has a duty of care over the students.
12. All participants must exit the Court House by 8.30pm (8.00pm for trials in the Mandurah Court House).
